

Chezy Champs 2021 COVID Protocols

We plan to have the following COVID-specific restrictions in place for Chezy Champs 2021:

- Masks required at all times
- All attendees must be fully vaccinated as defined by the US CDC.
- All teams limited to 20 people total (plus anyone with an assigned event volunteer role), including at least one chaperone per 10 students. The 20 people must remain constant through all 3 days of the event and includes students, mentors, teachers, parents, coaches, etc.
- No non-team-affiliated spectators.
- No loaner safety glasses will be provided. All participants must bring their own safety glasses.
- No eating or drinking is permitted indoors anywhere at Chezy Champs. We'll have plenty of outdoor space and seating available in the grassy campus quad.
- Due to foodservice restrictions, no meals will be offered for sale. We'll still have pre-packaged snacks and drink available for sale and will provide a list of local restaurants offering take-out. Volunteers will receive separate communication detailing volunteer food plans.

Per CDPH rules, we will verify vaccination status of all attendees. We plan to have a check-in station where all participants will need to show proof of vaccination and will receive a wristband before being allowed entry into the event. Teams will be limited to 20 participants total (including students, mentors, teachers, parents, coaches, etc). Acceptable proof of vaccination is defined by the CDPH ([link](#)).

While we will try our best to facilitate an expedient check-in process, please expect some minor delays at check-in and plan to arrive a bit early. We are targeting 5pm opening of for participant check-in stations, 6pm pit opening, and 7pm beginning of practice matches (historically we have been able to open a bit early, but no promises).

The COVID situation in California is dynamic. Chezy Champs will comply with all applicable guidance from Santa Clara County and the State of California. Additional restrictions may be added at the discretion of Team 254 and Bellarmine. Any restrictions will be announced before the event begins. Event organizers & FIRST reserve the right to cancel the event in the event of emergencies or other extraordinary situations.
